

CDC France Fly



Materials

Thread: 70 Denier Olive Thread

Body: Tail- 4 Coq De Leon fibers, body is ribbed with Olive Micro Tubing, Collar uses Natural Dun CDC and a light wrap of Hends Spectra Dubbing after CDC is added. Olive color and package says "code 239".

Hardware: Sz 14-18 jig hook; 2.4mm-3.2mm slotted tungsten bead (silver preferred)

Steps

- 1- Secure bead with touching wraps of olive 70 denier thread
- 2- Wrap to bend of hook and then add in your 4 CDL fibers
- 3- Wrap up to bead and secure your micro tubing
- 4.) Once secure, pull on the tubing lightly to thin it out some and then wrap your thread over the thin tubing until you get back to the CDL fibers
- 5.) Either hand wrap, or use rotary function of vise to get touching wraps of the micro tubing up to the bead of the hook
- 6.) Secure thread with two wraps behind and then in front of tubing and cut off excess
- 7.) Add in CDC fibers with either a hackle plier and wrap, or use a split thread technique
- 8.) Use a dubbing noodle with a very small amount of Hends Spectra dubbing and create a collar between the bead and CDC
- 9.) Double whip finish and you are done. I would highly suggest a little head cement or UV resin to secure the head of the fly/durability.
